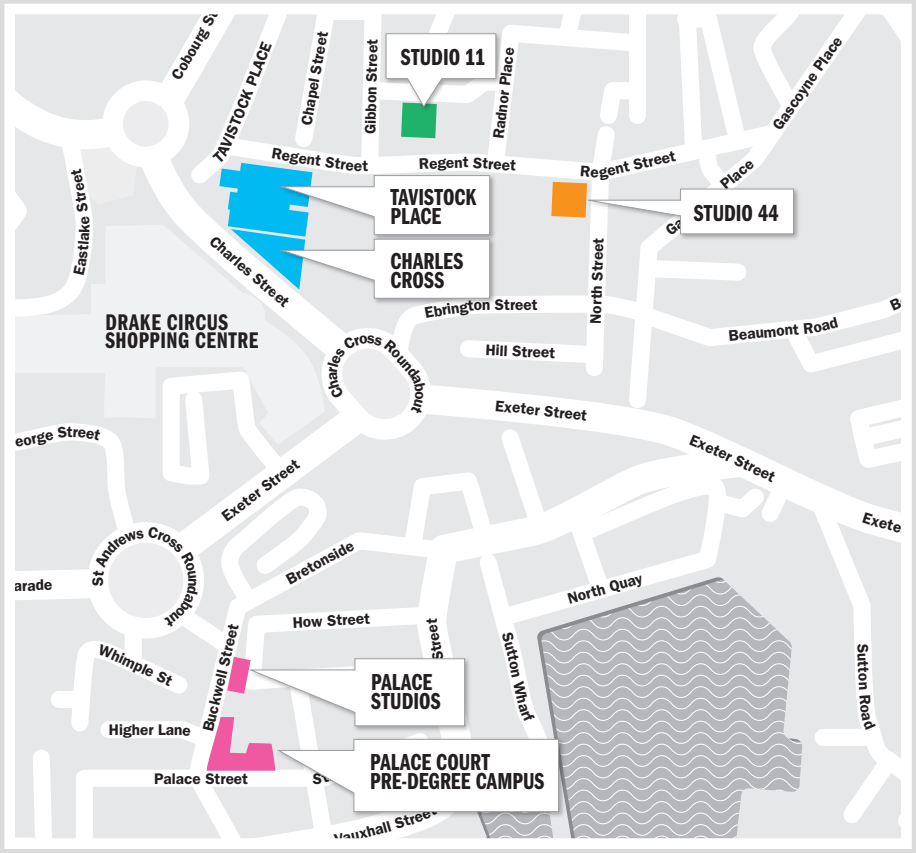
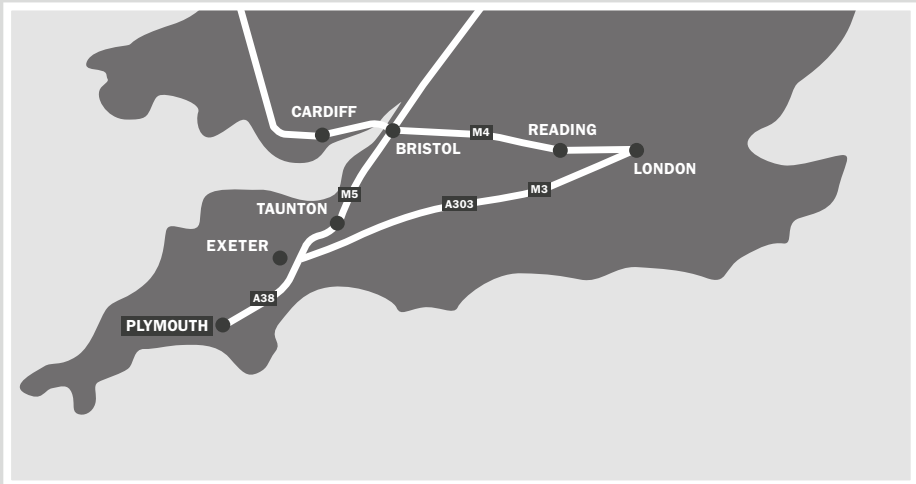

WITH YOUR BIKE

We have cycle racks outside the college and maps of local bicycle routes. If travelling by train do check regulations as you may have to pay to travel with your bike. Search online for information about two National Cycling Routes; NCN27 (Devon to Ilfracombe) and the English south coast route NCN2; there are some beautiful sections close by and a small network of local ferries that take cyclists and foot passengers to The Royal William Yard, Kingsand and Cawsand and other seaside locations. COMING BY COACH

Plymouth coach station is a short 15 minute walk away from our main site, Tavistock Place. National Express services run from London Victoria, Bristol, Exeter and many other UK destinations. Follow signs for Drake Circus Shopping Centre, and find the college situated just behind Charles Street. Contact National Express enquiries **+44 (0)870 580 8080** or visit nationalexpress.com. ARRIVING BY CAR

If you have to travel by car, use the Regent Street Car Park just next door to our HE campus as we have limited parking for disabled access only at Tavistock Place. For more information on parking visit Plymouth City Council website plymouth.gov.uk and the Park and Ride section.

FROM THE NORTH

The main route from the North is via the M5 motorway and then continuing on the A38 Expressway via Exeter.

- » Follow signs for the City Centre and keep left when approaching the roundabout
- » Take the first exit on the roundabout signposted 'City Centre'. (Please take note of the sliproad going into Sainsburys that feeds off this first left turn)
- » Continue to follow signs for the City Centre until you approach a second roundabout
- » Take the first exit and move into the far right hand lane.
- » On the approach to Charles Cross roundabout (with church ruin) take the third exit and the next immediate left
- » Turn left at the junction and you will see Regent Street Car Park on the left hand side.
- » Plymouth College of Art is the next building on the left.

FROM CORNWALL

The main route from Cornwall is via the A38 Expressway, follow signs towards Plymouth.

- » From the Tamar Bridge take the third exit onto Manadon roundabout and follow the signs for City Centre and Mutley Plain
- » Keep to the left and continue straight ahead for about 15mins. You will pass through Mutley Plain and will see the Hyde Park Pub on the approach to Mutley.
- » Continue down North Hill and keep to the left.
- » At the traffic lights, keep in the left hand lane and on the approach to the roundabout (with the church ruin) take the first exit and the next immediate left
- » Turn left at the junction and you will see Regent Street Car Park on the left hand side.
- » Plymouth College of Art is the next building on the left.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

We're just 5 minutes away from Plymouth rail station where direct services run to London Paddington (between three and three and a half hours), Bristol, the Midlands, the North of England, Scotland and Penzance. There is even a sleeper train to and from Paddington if you want to leave Plymouth late and arrive early to London. IF WALKING FROM THE TRAIN STATION:

- » Please follow signs for the City Centre
- » On the approach to North Cross roundabout, take the exit on the left
- » Follow this road until you see Drake Circus Shopping Centre appear on the right
- » The college is located opposite the shopping centre

INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS

The closest regional airports are Exeter, Newquay and Bristol and direct coach services also connect Plymouth with Heathrow and Gatwick in London. Plymouth is connected to Roscoff in France and Santander in Spain by regular car and foot passenger services. Visit brittany-ferries.com to find out more.
