SHOW US:

Your ideas – we can explore a multitude of routes.

Confidence – talent is an attitude.
Notebooks, diaries, sketchbooks, artists books, zines.

Your body of work. This could be objects, images, text, sound work, moving image, web platforms, performance, etc. and may be presented either physically or digitally.

Your body of work should contain no more than 20 pieces.
